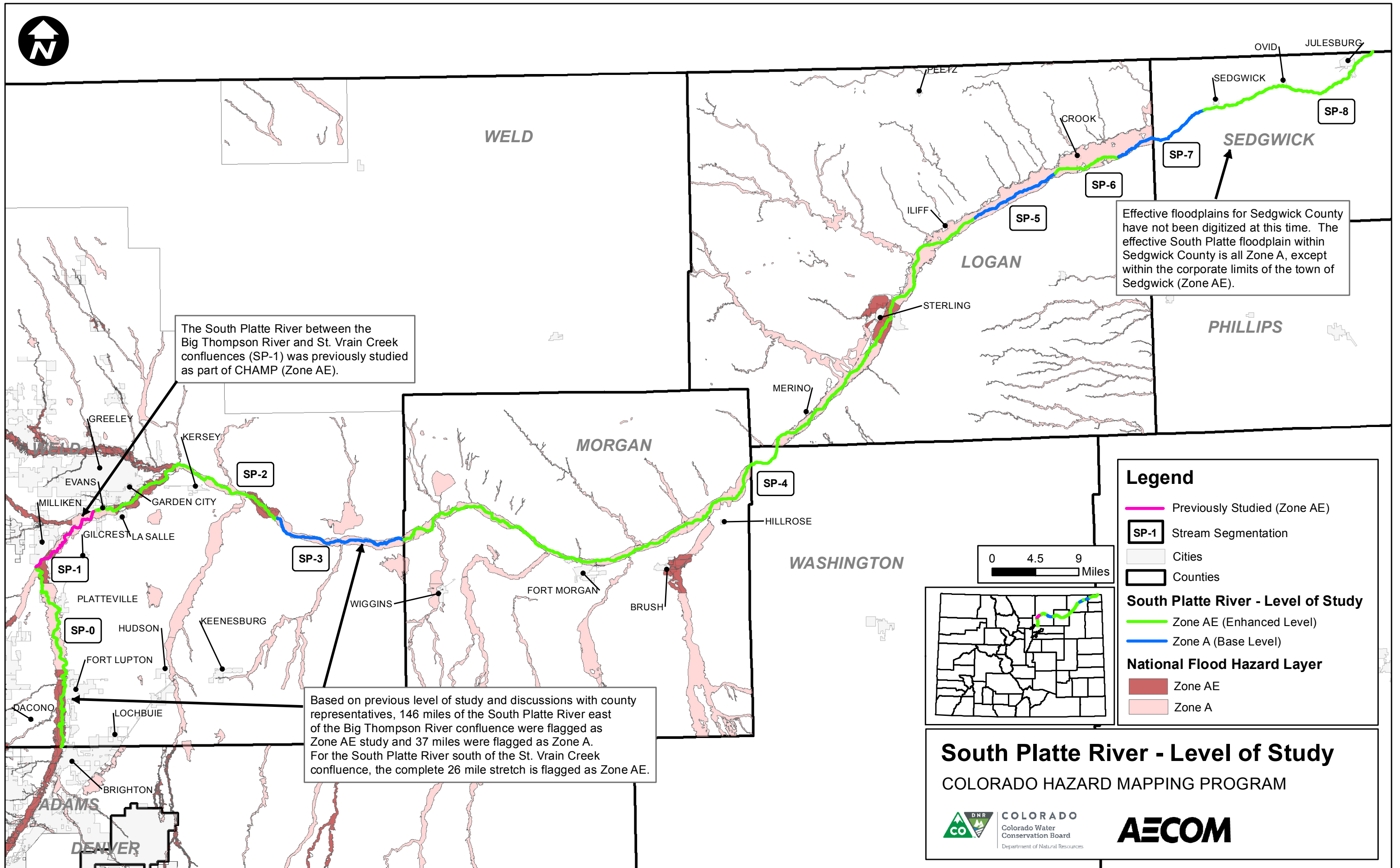




The South Platte River between the Big Thompson River and St. Vrain Creek confluences (SP-1) was previously studied as part of CHAMP (Zone AE).

Effective floodplains for Sedgwick County have not been digitized at this time. The effective South Platte floodplain within Sedgwick County is all Zone A, except within the corporate limits of the town of Sedgwick (Zone AE).

Based on previous level of study and discussions with county representatives, 146 miles of the South Platte River east of the Big Thompson River confluence were flagged as Zone AE study and 37 miles were flagged as Zone A. For the South Platte River south of the St. Vrain Creek confluence, the complete 26 mile stretch is flagged as Zone AE.
