See the floodplain permit entrance requirements. Applications and submittals go through the SUDP process and must be submitted electronically. Submission information can be found at the Development Services SUDP page.• To determine if a project is located in a floodplain go to the Denver GIS Floodplain Map and search an address or click on the map for basic floodplain information.
