Sec. 10-16. - Building and fire code adopted.

The International Building Code ("IBC"), International Energy Conservation Code ("IECC"), the International Fire Code ("IFC"), the International Fuel Gas Code ("IFGC"), the International Mechanical Code ("IMC"), the International Plumbing Code ("IPC"), and the International Residential Code ("IRC"), all series of 2009 as published by the International Code Council, all errata to the above codes as published by the International Code Council and the amendments to the above codes and the administration of the Denver Building Code, as filed May 24, 2011, in City Clerk File Number 11-427 are hereby adopted collectively as the Denver Building and Fire Code.

The current national electrical code, as currently adopted by the State of Colorado or as is from time to time modified, re-enacted or re-adopted by the State of Colorado is hereby adopted as the electrical code of the City and County of Denver.
